



# Diesel Emissions Reduction Grant Opportunity Request for Proposals

Applications are being accepted by The Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) for projects to reduce diesel emissions. KDHE received funding from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency to support voluntary clean diesel projects across the state.

The funds, provided by the National Clean Diesel Campaign as part of the Diesel Emissions Reductions Act (DERA), will go to the KDHE Diesel Emissions Reduction Grant. The money will be used to assist diesel equipment owners and operators in making improvements that will help the environment.

Some of the eligible projects include

- engine idling reduction
- retrofit technologies
- engine upgrade and replacement
- vehicle replacement
- low rolling resistance tires
