2) **Updates**

- LEED Certification – the LEED criteria system is being updated. The new version is expected in early 2008. There will hopefully be some clean construction points involved. - **looking for the language**
- Two NCDC videos – The video for the state and local municipalities **is available** and one for contractors. The municipalities' video is focusing on NY's MTA project. The contractor video is focused on TX and Chicago footage and will optimistically be ready sometime this fall.

- EPA Regions (including 7) are considering putting “points” into Superfund clean-up contract proposals

3) **CA’s Off-Road, In-Use Mobile Rule** - Kim Heroy-Rogalski, California Air Resource Board (CARB)

- This factsheet at www.arb.ca.gov/msprog/ordiesel/ordiesel.htm tells the basic details of the regulation that Kim presented
- The question was asked about pay-outs from the Carl Moyer program to comply with the regulation, but Carl Moyer will only pay for projects that are beyond the regulation once it starts in 2010
- The South Coast district is trying to push more and they may use the Carl Moyer Program
- Ken Katch mentioned that there has been an influx of \$ requests through Carl Moyer for off-road equipment before the rule comes into effect
- Marty Matthews stated that there is concern that this could hurt business and significant analysis has been made by contractors... construction groups say that the cost will be 4 times the \$3-3.5 billion that CARB estimates
- What does this mean in the Blue Skyways States?
 - There is concern that this regulation could spread
 - Marty said that they are working w/ CAT and local dealers to put a demo project together in Kansas City
 - Bill Gill asked if a state were to take an approach like CA only w/ more feelers to the economics of the industry, how would that be perceived?
 - Marty said it would be better
 - Pre-emption of a rule would only occur if it was adopted as written by CARB
 - CARB has been asked to split the rule into 2 parts for states that want to pick between PM and NOx emissions
 - Bill asked if a non-attainment area could adopt a CA type rule to offset emissions?
